OUR YEAR

Letter from our Executive Director



Dear LOVEboldly Community,

Y'all, 2025 was a rough year. What we thought *might* be a tough year quickly escalated into an all out assault on our rights and the soul of our nation. It was impossible to miss how important our work at LOVEboldly really is, but we did it in a landscape which targeted and defunded many programs impacting the LGBTQIA+ community.

But this year also brought some strong moments of joy. We brought on three new board members including Cass Helm, the Rev. Brian Steele, and the Rev. Iva Joyce-Miesse. Then on Easter Sunday we launched *Coming Out Christian*, a podcast exploring the dual experience of coming out as an LGBTQIA+ person in Christian spaces and “coming out” as a Christian in LGBTQIA+ spaces. The podcast released two seasons with 27 guests during 2025.

LOVEboldly sponsored or co-sponsored 11 programs and continued to engage with a dynamic group of partner coalitions and organizations.

LOVEboldly continued to be recognized as a voice for Queer Christians and Queer people of faith in general in 2025. We were once again called upon to lend expertise and our collective lived experience in more spaces, including at the Ohio Statehouse and in the media. We published op-eds, provided testimony before various Ohio House and Ohio Senate committees, and joined multiple organizational letters.

Yet for all our success, the work continues on all fronts. We give thanks to our gracious and empowering God for all the blessings of 2025 and we also thank you, our supporters, donors, volunteers, partners, and community for all that you brought to this movement. We know that the coming years will bring more challenges, but we're ready to tackle them with you.

Executive Director Stats

In addition to formal programs, LOVEboldly's executive director, Rev. Dr. Ben, spends a significant amount of time meeting one-on-one with people and working in groups. Ben estimates that he spent **more than 250 hours** during 2025 meeting with people. That's in addition to all the unscheduled meetings and phone calls which Ben and the Board respond to throughout the year.

Programming - Expansion

During the second half of 2025, LOVEboldly began a concerted effort to renew our in-person, on-the-ground programming beyond Central Ohio. Through the efforts of volunteers in Cincinnati, particularly Ron Roark, we were able to begin offering substantive social and educational programs there. Our goal is to continue this push throughout Ohio in 2026.

Resource Development

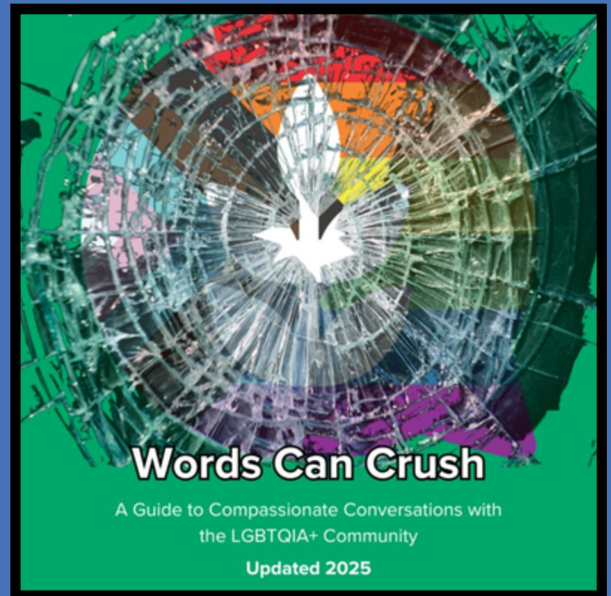
LOVEboldly spent significant time during 2024 revising and creating new resources for LGBTQIA+ people of faith and their allies.

Grace and Glitter: A Queer Devotional for 2026

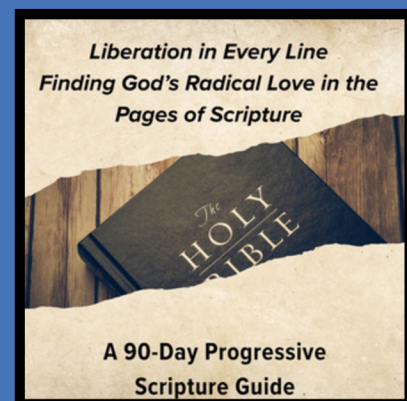

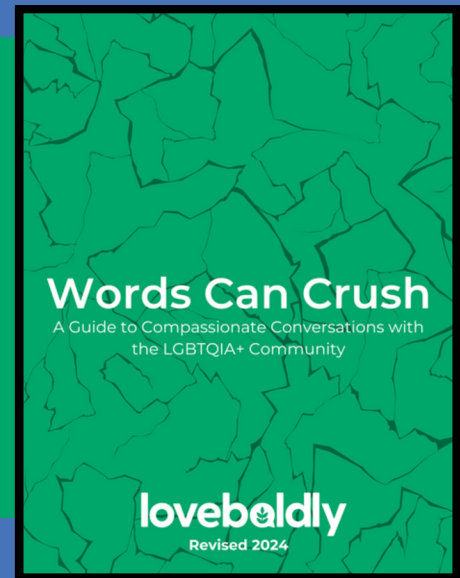
Looking Ahead into 2026
